BALLS/SCOREBOARDS/NET	andro (balls: plastic, white)
REGULATIONS:	The tournament will be played according to the ITTF Rules, the Regulations of the DTTB and the implementing regulations of the WTTV, except for the time-out rule and differing size of playing-boxes.
TTR-RELEVANCE:	The single tournament is in first, second and consolation round relevant for TTR.
MODE:	The tournament will be carried out as an age-group-tournament for singles and teams (girls and boys separated). An age group is formed by all kids who are born between the 1 st of January and the 31 st of December of the respective year.
SETTLEMENT/SKILL LEVEL:	<p>The organizer does the settlement in every competition. Please specify the performance level of players who are listed in national/county rankings in the entry form.</p> <p>For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 3rd Place „Endrangliste des Westdeutschen-Tischtennis-Verbandes” . Detail „Spielstärke” in the registration: 3.WTTV-ER - 16th Place „Schüler-Rangliste” national association (DTTB). Detail „Spielstärke” in the registration: 16. DTTB
STARTING NUMBER:	The starting number is to be carried the whole tournament visible on the back.
FIXTURES:	The fixtures are set automatically according to the timetable. Players have to appear at the indicated place 15 minutes prior to the match without being called.
2nd TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT:	The 2 nd Tournament Management is under the leading tournament and is responsible for a part of all tables. They are marked with a capital letter.
TOURNAMENT NOTICE:	During the tournament you can see the completely timetable of all competitions at the notices.
CLOTHING/MATERIAL:	Participants have to wear sneakers with bright soles! Sportswear is recommended. The jersey must not be white.
RACKET CONTROLS:	<p>There are racket controls. The tests are carried out with approved test equipment, usually before the game.</p> <p>Rackets, which are not correspondent with the ITTF-rules, may not be used in a game. The player has a one-time chance to change the racket. In this case and also in the suspicion case a control is carried out after decision of the referee after the play. With positive findings the game is evaluated as lost.</p>
DECISION COMMITTEE:	If there is a change before or during the tournament, the committee of organizing would decide.

SINGLE COMPETITION:

Singles

Every girl and every boy – with or without handicap – born in 2001 or later is able to start in her/his suitable age group (01/01-31/12).

- 01 Girls and boys 2001 (1.1. -31.12.2001)
- 02 Girls and boys 2002 (1.1. -31.12.2002)
- 03 Girls and boys 2003 (1.1. -31.12.2003)
- 04 Girls and Boys 2004 (1.1. -31.12.2004)
- 05 Girls and boys 2005 (1.1. -31.12.2005)
- 06 Girls and boys 2006 (1.1. -31.12.2006)
- 07 Girls and boys 2007 (1.1. -31.12.2007)
- 08 Girls and boys 2008+ younger (starting 1.1.2008)

Examples:

- Rainer Zufall, born 05/05/2001 -> age-group "boys 2001" / "JE 2001")
- Melanie Muster, born 24/12/2004 -> age-group "girls 2005 / "ME 2005")

Note

Every player is only allowed to start in one (= in his) age group.
Boys and girls are playing in separated tournament classes.
Participants do not have to be member of a club!

SINGLES RESUMPTION:

Mode

The preliminary round is carried out in groups (with 4 players, if necessary with 3 players). The games are played until the first player win the third set (best of five). Decisive for the final result of a group is the number of victories. If two or more players finish with the same number of victories, the difference in games determines the group placing. Is this also levelled, the direct comparison to each other with victories, difference in games and difference in balls decides.
The first and the second of a group proceed to the main draw. The third and the fourth of a group have the chance to play the consolation-round.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The preliminary round takes place on Saturday (19th August 2017). The matches, also in the main round or consolation round, take place in the order of the timetable.

MAIN / 2nd ROUND

ELIGIBLE FOR MAIN ROUND:

The first and second player in each preliminary round.

MODE:

The main round is a K.O.-system and it is played in a best of five mode. The winner of every match gets to the next round.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The K.O. games (main round) take places on Sunday of the tournament (20th August 2017).

CONSOLATION ROUND:

ELIGIBLE FOR CONSOLATION ROUND: For players ranked third and fourth after group stage

MODE: The consolation round will be played in the KO-system and it is played in a best of five mode. The winner gets to the next round.

GENERAL INFORMATION: The consolation round is played at official competition tables. The K.O.-matches are played at Saturday and Sunday. The best four in every age group win non-cash prizes.

DOUBLE COMPETITION:

AGE GROUPS:
 09 Girls and boys 2001/02 (1.1.2001-31.12.2002)
 10 Girls and boys 2003/04 (1.1.2003-31.12.2004)
 11 Girls and boys 2005/06 (1.1.2005-31.12.2006)
 12 Girls and boys 2007+ younger (starting 1.1.2007)

ELIGIBLE FOR DOUBLE C.: Every girl and every boy – with or without handicap – born in 2001 or later is able to participate in the double competition. Girls/Boys who are born in the same age group can start as a double. The doubles can be freely announced (different clubs or schools). Mixed doubles (a girl and a boy) and double-starts are not possible. A partner can also be found by lot by the organisation committee.

MODE: The **preliminary round** is carried out in **groups** (with 4 doubles). The games are played until the first double win the third set (best of five). Decisive for the final result of a group is the number of victories. If two or more doubles finish with the same number of victories, the difference in games determines the group placing. If this is also levelled, the direct comparison to each other with victories, difference in games and difference in balls decides.
 The **first and the second** of a group proceed to the **main draw**. The **third and the fourth** of a group have the chance to play the **consolation-round**.

GENERAL INFORMATION: The preliminary round takes place on Friday (18th August 2017). The matches, also in the main round or consolation round, take place in the order of the timetable.

MAIN ROUND:

ELIGIBLE FOR MAIN ROUND: The **first and second ranked doubles** after the preliminary round of the double competition.

MODE: The main round will be played in the KO-system and it is played in a best of five mode. The winner gets to the next round.

GENERAL INFORMATION: The main round takes place on Friday and Saturday of the tournament. The presentation ceremony starts after the final for each competition. The best four will be honoured.

CONSOLATION ROUND:

ELIGIBLE FOR DOUBLE ROUND: For doubles ranked third and fourth after group stage of the double competition.

MODE: The consolation round is played in a K.O. system and in one long set (game) to 15 points (2 points lead). The service changes after two points. After eight points the returning player changes. No changeover! The winner gets to the next round.
(changes reserve)

GENERAL INFORMATION: The consolation round is played at official competition tables. The K.O.-matches are played at Friday and Saturday. The best four in every age group win non-cash prizes.

NRW-TALENT-CUP: For boys and girls born in 2008 or later only

Mode

1. Table tennis competition (girls' singles / boys' singles)
2. Test of the physical conditions, consisting of six disciplines (sprint, standing long jump, throwing the heavy ball, pitching a ball to a goal, slalom-dribbling, sidesteps).
(Changes of the disciplines and of the number of disciplines are possible)

Evaluation system

The ranking of each of the two competitions (table tennis / physical conditions) will be assessed with points (1 point for the 1st place, 2 points for 2nd place, etc.).

The overall result of NRW-Talent-Cup is made up from the evaluation of the two parts at a rate of 1:1. Winner will be the boy and the girl with the fewest points.

Note

The best four girls and boys of the NRW-Talent-Cup will be awarded.
(The winners of the table tennis competition will be awarded separately in the context of the andro Kids Open)

IMPORTANT NOTES:

APPLICATION: You can only register online at www.kids-open.borussia-duesseldorf.com. You may make your entries between 5th January 2017 and 23rd July 2017

Our service for you:

- You receive a confirmation of your entry via email
- You receive your invoice via email, as well as a confirmation of participation after you have finished the entry-process.

Advice:

- 1. The starting fee (and fee for hotel/gym) automatically results with the registration.**
2. A registration is only complete, when the proof of the age has come in.
3. The registration is finished, if the invoice is payed and the proof is raised.

PROOF:

You can enclose to the registration a **certification of birth or an excerpt from click-tt for the proof of the age of the player.**

This is possible during the registration, with an E-Mail, post or fax. You have to give the ID (number) of the coach.

You have to give the proof until the 23rd July to the organizer. **If the proof didn't reach the organizer until the date of 23rd July 2017 a participation isn't possible.**

The costs are calculated.

Wrong statements lead to the immediate disqualification in all competitions!

LATE APPLICATIONS:

For organisational reasons applications after the 23rd of July 2017 cannot be accepted.
