<b>TABLES:</b>	80 (andro Competition, andro Magnum)
<b>BALLS/SCOREBOARDS/NET:</b>	andro (balls: plastic, white)
<b>REGULATIONS:</b>	The tournament will be played according to the ITTF Rules, the Regulations of the DTTB and the implementing regulations of the WTTV, <b>except for the time-out rule</b> and differing size of playing-boxes.
<b>TTR-RELEVANCE:</b>	The single tournament is in first, second and consolation round relevant for TTR.
<b>MODE:</b>	The tournament will be carried out as an <b>age-group-tournament</b> for singles and doubles (girls and boys separated). An age group is formed by all kids who are born between the 1 <sup>st</sup> of January and the 31 <sup>st</sup> of December of the respective year. Doubles age groups are formed by two years (exceptive 2002).
<b>NEW:</b>	<b>For the anniversary event, a class for 17-year-olds will be introduced. These participate in the single and double competition in the year 2002.</b>
<b>SETTLEMENT/SKILL LEVEL:</b>	The organizer does the settlement in every competition. Please specify the performance level of players who are listed in national/county rankings in the entry form.
<b>STARTING NUMBER:</b>	The starting number is to be carried the whole tournament visible on the back.
<b>FIXTURES:</b>	The fixtures are set automatically according to the timetable. Players have to appear at the indicated place 15 minutes prior to the match without being called.
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT:</b>	The 2 <sup>nd</sup> Tournament Management is under the leading tournament and is responsible for a part of all tables. They are marked with a capital letter.
<b>TOURNAMENT NOTICE:</b>	During the tournament you can see the completely timetable of all competitions at the notices.
<b>CLOTHING/MATERIAL:</b>	Participants have to wear sneakers with bright soles! Sportswear is recommended. The jersey must not be white.
<b>RACKET CONTROLS:</b>	There are racket controls. The tests are carried out with approved test equipment, usually before the game.  Rackets, which are not correspondent with the ITTF-rules, may not be used in a game. The player has a one-time chance to change the racket. In this case and also in the suspicion case a control is carried out after decision of the referee after the play. With positive findings the game is evaluated as lost.
<b>DECISION COMMITTEE:</b>	If there is a change before or during the tournament, the committee of organizing would decide.

**SINGLE COMPETITION:**

**Singles**

Every girl and every boy – with or without handicap – born in 2002 or later is able to start in her/his suitable age group (01/01-31/12).

- 01 Girls and boys 2002 (1.1. -31.12.2002)
- 02 Girls and boys 2003 (1.1. -31.12.2003)
- 03 Girls and boys 2004 (1.1. -31.12.2004)
- 04 Girls and Boys 2005 (1.1. -31.12.2005)
- 05 Girls and boys 2006 (1.1. -31.12.2006)
- 06 Girls and boys 2007 (1.1. -31.12.2007)
- 07 Girls and boys 2008 (1.1. -31.12.2008)
- 08 Girls and boys 2009 (1.1. -31.12.2009)
- 09 Girls and boys 2010+ younger (starting 1.1.2010)

Examples:

- Rainer Zufall, born 05/05/2002 -> age-group "boys 2002" / "JE 2002")
- Melanie Muster, born 24/12/2006 -> age-group "girls 2006 / "ME 2006")

**Note**

Every player is only allowed to start in one (= in his) age group.  
Boys and girls are playing in separated tournament classes.  
Participants do not have to be member of a club!

**SINGLES RESUMPTION:**

**Mode**

It is played over 3 winning sets. The preliminary round is carried out in groups (with 4 players, if necessary with 3 players). Decisive for the final result of a group is the number of victories. If two or more players finish with the same number of victories, the difference in games determines the group placing. Is this also levelled, the direct comparison to each other with victories, difference in games and difference in balls decides.

The first and the second of a group proceed to the main draw. The third and the fourth of a group have the chance to play the consolation-round.

The main and also the consolation round are played in a K.O.-system. The winner of every match gets to the next round.

**GENERAL INFORMATION:**

The game fixtures (in groups, main and consolation rounds) are made according to a fixed schedule (see General Information / Timetable). The award ceremonies of all ages take place on Sunday after the finals. The best four will be awarded.

## DOUBLE COMPETITION:

### AGE GROUPS:

10 Girls and boys 2002 (1.1.2002–31.12.2002) **new for the anniversary**  
11 Girls and boys 2003/04 (1.1.2003–31.12.2004)  
12 Girls and boys 2005/06 (1.1.2005–31.12.2006)  
13 Girls and boys 2007/08 (1.1.2007–31.12.2008)  
14 Girls and boys 2009+ younger (starting 1.1.2009)

### ELIGIBLE FOR DOUBLE C.:

Every girl and every boy – with or without handicap – born in 2002 or later is able to participate in the double competition. Girls/Boys who are born in the same age group can start as a double. The doubles can be freely announced (different clubs or schools). Mixed doubles (a girl and a boy) and double-starts are not possible. A partner can also be found by lot by the organisation committee.

### MODE:

The **preliminary round** is carried out in **groups** (with 4 doubles). The games are played until the first double win the third set (best of five). Decisive for the final result of a group is the number of victories. If two or more doubles finish with the same number of victories, the difference in games determines the group placing. If this is also levelled, the direct comparison to each other with victories, difference in games and difference in balls decides.

The **first and the second** of a group proceed to the **main draw**. The **third and the fourth** of a group have the chance to play the **consolation-round**.

The main round will be played in the KO-system and it is played in a best of five mode. The winner gets to the next round.

The consolation round is played in a K.O. system and in one long set (game) to 15 points ( 2 points lead). The service changes after two points. After eight points the returning player changes. No changeover! The winner gets to the next round.

### GENERAL INFORMATION:

The group matches take place on the Friday of the event. The fixtures, also in the main and consolation rounds, are made according to a fixed schedule (see General Information / Timetable). The award ceremonies of all ages take place after the finals. The best four of the main and consolation rounds will be awarded.

**NRW-TALENT-CUP:****For boys and girls born in 2010 or later only****Mode**

1. Table tennis competition (girls' singles / boys' singles)
2. Test of the physical conditions, consisting of six disciplines (sprint, standing long jump, throwing the heavy ball, pitching a ball to a goal, slalom-dribbling, sidesteps).  
(Changes of the disciplines and of the number of disciplines are possible)

**Evaluation system**

The ranking of each of the two competitions (table tennis / physical conditions) will be assessed with points (1 point for the 1st place, 2 points for 2nd place, etc.).

The overall result of NRW-Talent-Cup is made up from the evaluation of the two parts at a rate of 1:1. Winner will be the boy and the girl with the fewest points.

**Note**

The best four girls and boys of the NRW-Talent-Cup will be awarded.  
(The winners of the table tennis competition will be awarded separately in the context of the andro Kids Open)

**IMPORTANT NOTES:****APPLICATION:**

You can only register online at [www.kids-open.borussia-duesseldorf.com](http://www.kids-open.borussia-duesseldorf.com). You may make your entries between 10<sup>th</sup> January 2017 and 21<sup>st</sup> July 2019.

**Our service for you:**

- You receive a confirmation of your entry via email
- You receive your invoice via email, as well as a confirmation of participation after you have finished the entry-process.

**Advice:**

1. **The starting fee (and fee for hotel/gym) automatically results with the registration.**
2. A registration is only complete, when the proof of the age has come in.
3. The registration is finished, if the invoice is payed and the proof is raised.

**PROOF:**

You can enclose to the registration a **certification of birth or an excerpt from click-tt for the proof of the age of the player.**

This is possible during the registration, with an E-Mail, post or fax. You have to give the ID (number) of the coach.

You have to give the proof until the 21<sup>st</sup> July to the organizer. **If the proof didn't reach the organizer until the date of 21<sup>st</sup> July 2019 a participation isn't possible.**

The costs are calculated.

**Wrong statements lead to the immediate disqualification in all competitions!**

- CHANGES:** Changes of application, for example due to disease, can only be accepted up to the closing date (23/07/2017)
- LATE APPLICATIONS:** For organisational reasons applications after the 21<sup>st</sup> of July 2019 cannot be accepted.
- REFUND:** If you sign off participants before the end of the registration period, you will get your entry fee minus an administrative charge of € 10,00 back. The fee for overnight stays will be refunded with 4 € per night.  
There is no right of refund for the entry fee for players who do not start at the competition or sign off after the end of the registration period.
- STARTING DOCUMENTS:** The attendant named in the application will receive all starting documents (starting numbers, information) on the 3<sup>th</sup> August 2019.  
Precondition: The registration is finished (invoice is paid, proof was given).
- SCHOOL RELEASE (FOR PARTICIPANTS LIVING IN GERMANY):** Participants can, according to “§43 Abs. 3 of School law (SchulG) of Nordrhein-Westfalen (NRW)”, be released from school by their parents if they have an important reason. The andro Kids Open are one of the outstanding events in Germany and were in the last few years from schools - not just in NRW - accepted as an “important reason”.  
  
On enquiry you can get an official form for the school release from Borussia Düsseldorf.
- ATTENDANT:** We assume that there is an attendant for every club, school or single participant during the whole tournament. The organiser cannot assume any supervisory responsibilities.
- JURY:** If it should be necessary to make modifications during the tournament, decisions are made by the organisation committee.
- EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY:** Borussia Düsseldorf cannot be held liable for property damage, burglary or accidents.
- FOR THE ENVIRONMENT:** We want to keep the sports- and overnight hall during the 30<sup>th</sup> andro Kids Open clean and we count on the support of the participants.
- „BUNDESLIGA” HOME MATCH:** On the weekend of the andro Kids Open there is a home match of Borussia Düsseldorf. The participants and the coaches/parents of them can buy a ticket for a lower price. You can buy these tickets during the tournament. Only as long as the stock reaches.
